

## **Privacy Policy**

This policy describes the ways we collect, store, use and protects your personal information. You accepted this policy by providing your personal information and creating an account on our website. ### **How we collect information about you**

When you visit the NSI website, we collect your IP address and standard web log information, such as your browser type and the pages you accessed on our website.

If you open an account with NSI, we collect the following types of information from you:

- Contact information – your name, address, phone number, email and other similar information.
- Optional information – optional contact or generic information that is not required to setup an account such as a cell phone number or favorite places to shop.

In addition to collecting the above information, we may collect additional information from or about you in other ways not specifically described here. For example, we may collect information related to your contact with our customer or technical support team or store results when you respond to a survey.

## **How we use cookies**

When you access our website, we, or companies we work with or contract with may track how our website is used and may place small data files called “cookies” on your computer.

We send a “session cookie” to your computer when you log in to your account at NSI. This type of cookie helps us to recognize you if you visit multiple pages on our site during the same session, so that we don’t need to ask you for your password on each page. Once you log out or close your browser, this cookie expires and no longer has any effect.

We encode our cookies so that only we can interpret the information stored in them. You are free to decline our cookies if your browser permits, but doing so may interfere with your use of our website.

## **How we protect and store personal information**

We store and process your personal information on systems provided by our hosting provider. This information is protected by maintaining physical, electronic and procedural safeguards in compliance with applicable US federal and state regulations. Our hosting provider uses safeguards such as firewalls, intrusion prevention systems, and data encryption as well as restricts physical access to their buildings and files and only authorizes access to personal information if required by employees who require it to perform their job duties.

## **How we use the personal information we collect**

Our primary goal in collecting personal information is to provide you with a customized, safe, and efficient experience. In addition to this, we may use your personal information to:

- Process transactions for products and services and send notices about your transactions;
- Send you information, service update notices, promotional offers based on your communication preferences;
- Prevent potentially prohibited or illegal activities, and enforce our User Agreement;
- Provide customer service and support you require;

When using NSI’s website, you may need to pay for products, services or invoices in which we may need to share some of your personal information with Intuit PaymentNetwork or PayPal’s website in order to complete the transaction. Please refer to Intuit PaymentNetwork or PayPal’s privacy policy for further clarification.

If you are buying products or services and use the e-commerce feature of this site, NSI may receive a confirmation email with a confirmed credit card billing address. NSI will not use this information to market our services to you unless you have agreed to it.

### **How we share personal information with other parties**

NSI will not share, lease, rent, or sell your personal information without their explicit permission to do so.

### **How you can access or change your personal information**

You can review and edit your personal information at any time by logging in to your account and clicking the profile sub tab under the My Account tab if you are logged in to PayPal. If you are logged into NSI's website, just login with your username and password and update your profile.
